IF SANCTION REQUESTS ARE RECEIVED LESS THAN 25 BUSINESS DAYS BEFORE THE REQUESTED DATE, A DOUBLE SANCTION FEE AND FULL INSURANCE PREMIUM MUST ACCOMPANY THE APPLICATION. SANCTION APPLICATIONS (EXCEPT NATIONALS) MUST BE RECEIVED 14 DAYS IN ADVANCE, OR SANCTION REQUEST MAY NOT BE HONORED.**

Standard AMA road events include: Reliability Run, Road Run, Field Meet, Poker Run, Lime Run, District Tour, Map Run, Egg Hunt, Scavenger Hunt, Road Enduro (Timed Road Run), District Rally, Gypsy Tour, Observation/Quiz Run, Dual Sport Ride, Dice Run, Road Rally, Midnight Run, Bingo Run, Carnival Run, Toy Run, Fun Run, Turkey Run, Convention, Bike Show, Mystery Run, Bike Blessing, Grand Tour, Swap Meet and Cruise In. *Please refer to current AMA Road Rulebook for further info.*

TERMS OF AGREEMENT: The applicant, in consideration of being granted a sanction and other good and valuable consideration, hereby agrees to conform to and comply with the applicable Road Riding Rule Book of the American Motorcyclist Association (the "Association") and individually the "AMA", as applicable, governing the sanctioned activity and further agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Association's officers, representatives and employees, from any and all liability, loss, cost or damage on account of any injury or death to any persons or property arising from or in any way resulting from the meet for which sanction is requested and associated activities, including all claims in consequence of the negligence of the applicant and employees, or by reason of improper premises, property equipment and conditions, and against all claims of liability and all loss, costs or damage of whatsoever kind and nature. The applicant further agrees to conduct the meet in compliance with all local, State and Federal vehicle laws wherever applicable.

In consideration of issuing a sanction, the Association, or its assigns, shall have all rights to broadcast any part or all of the sanctioned meet by radio, television, motion pictures or by any other means and to install the necessary equipment to do so in or about the premises and to retain all receipts therefrom for its own use. Any transcriptions shall be the sole property of the Association.

All advertisements must carry the wording "AMA Sanctioned" and display the AMA official logo as applicable.

It is understood that the applicant is solely responsible for the condition of buildings, facilities and equipment as well as for the condition of the premises upon which the sanctioned meet is scheduled.

It is understood that the applicant is solely responsible for and agrees to withhold or pay any and all taxes, and to file any tax and informational returns, which may be occasioned by or arise out of this meet (including without limitation the payment of prize or other money to riders), and which may be required by any applicable federal, state or local laws.

It is understood that the applicant may apply for, and the Association in its sole discretion may grant, a sanction for activity comprising a distinct portion or portions of the applicants entire program; provided that said portion or portions of the program would, if held separately from the rest of the program, constitute activity sanctionable by the Association and otherwise comply with all of the sanctioning requirements of the Association.

IMPORTANT: THE APPLICANT MAY NOT AT ANY TIME ASSUME A SANCTION WILL BE GRANTED, REGARDLESS OF COMMUNICATIONS AND EFFORTS TO WORK TOWARD A SATISFACTORY PROMOTED MEET. PRIOR TO SUCH NOTIFICATION, ANY AND ALL EXPENSES (E.G., ADVERTISING, PRINTING, RENTAL, ETC.) INCURRED AND ANY ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE APPLICANT IN ANTICIPATION OF THE MEET ARE AT THE APPLICANT'S SOLE RISK. UPON INQUIRY, THE ASSOCIATION WILL ADVISE THE APPLICANT OF THOSE MATTERS REMAINING TO BE DONE BEFORE THE WRITTEN NOTICE OF SANCTION GRANT WILL BE ISSUED.

INSURANCE: The Association administers this plan as a service to its chartered organizers. Chartered organizers are not required to purchase insurance through this plan; insurance may be obtained from any insurance agent/broker provided that the insurance policy and carrier meet all of the Association's insurance and risk management requirements. These requirements can be obtained by contacting the Association. Chartered organizers seeking to utilize alternative insurance must submit the information requested by the Association evidencing that the alternative insurance meets all of the Association's requirements, together with a \$350 processing fee, no later than 90 days prior to the event/activity to provide the Association with sufficient time to determine if the proposed alternative insurance is acceptable. Limits and premiums listed on this application apply only to sanctioned events described within the AMA or ATVA rule books. Coverage will be denied for any additional activities, entertainment, or exhibitions held in conjunction with the Associations sanctioned events unless said additional activities are specifically agreed to with the insurer in advance of the event and designated on the certificate of coverage.
